Arts & Crafts

Grades K-8. Creative fun with arts and crafts. Different projects each session.

The Art of Gliding/Glider Plane Visit

All ages. Come see a real glider plane, meet a glider pilot, and learn about the art of gliding. All children will make a glider.

The Art of Ice Cream

All ages. Make your own ice cream and create an edible work of art with lots of fun sundae toppings. (Allergy alert.)

Ballet and Creative Dance (presented by The Academy of the Performing Arts)

Grades K-5. Suzanna Rothgeb (assisted by Carol Pharo) directs this exciting new ballet and creative dance class. Our theme is *Peter and the Wolf*, with music by Prokofiev. No previous dance instruction required. Please wear clothes that are comfortable to move in.

Bring Nature to the Page! (Two sessions, attend either or both)

Grades 5-10. How do you capture a beautiful experience in words? We will explore the art of nature writing through pictures and foliage and discover different ways to capture the wonders of the world on paper. Different activities will be offered each evening.

Friends and Family CPR for Adults/Friends and Family CPR for Preteens/Teens

Adults/Grades 6-12. If a cardiac arrest happened to your loved one, would you know how to perform life-saving CPR? CPR can double the chances of survival. Learn the art of saving a life in this low pressure, but very informative class.

Great Stories (Two sessions, attend either or both)

Grades 5-10. Do you have a favorite book? What made it a favorite? What if you could write a great story like this? We'll share some exciting stories from children's books and experience writing in response to hearing great stories.

Guitar Class (presented by the Academy of the Performing Arts)

Grades 6-12. Bring your own guitar. Jason Hunt, newly arrived from Chicago, directs the guitar class. Rock, folk, jazz and classical styles will be explored. All levels from beginner to advanced, acoustic or electric, are welcome. (Note: Guitar class will continue in August every Monday evening for a small fee.)

Hodge Podge Science

Grades K-8. The art of wacky science! Join us for interesting experiments, wacky concoctions, and crazy contraptions.

Little Choir (presented by The Academy of the Performing Arts)

Grades K-5. The Little Choir, directed by Carol Pharo, is a training choir that includes and ear and voice training, choreography and *lots of fun*. Songs include Disney favorites, musicals such as *The Sound of Music*, and classical songs.

Quilting Fun

All ages. Create an appliquéd flower project. Different techniques will be available depending on age and skill level. The same project will be offered at all sessions. Additional embellishments such as a pieced frame may be added when the basic project is completed.

Ages 9 to 109. Learn the basics of making a scrapbook page and put your imaginations to work to make the page tell the story. Bring 5-10 photos that "go together" or several photos and a piece of memorabilia (*a ticket stub, etc). All other supplies are provided to create an 8.5"x11" album. Each week features a different theme, with theme-related supplies.

Water Park Fun

All ages. Come dressed to get wet and bring a towel! Join us for closely supervised water fun including sprinklers, water balloons, giant bubbles and more! Gentle water activities available for young children.
